Pilot "Food for Attendance" Program Shows Signs of Success



Would you send your child to school if you needed an extra hand on the farm?

Would you keep your child home from school if you needed help caring for your other children?

These are some of the reasons why attendance was poor at Sacred Heart School last year.

Children who miss school have difficulty learning. What can be done to increase attendance?



One idea to increase attendance is to provide food to children who come to school every day. It was decided to try this idea as a pilot program at Sacred Heart in 2019.

Because of your participation in fundraising activities, money was provided for the purchase of food. School personnel were directly involved in the distribution of food each Friday - for children who had attended school that week.

Father Faustin reported that "since the introduction of the program, children are more regular at school. For the month of May, the principal recorded only three absences for reasons of health and mortality."

We thank you for your support in making this pilot program possible. We will evaluate the data that we receive from Father and decide if the program should be repeated next year.

Haiti is currently experiencing political and economic crises.

This novena will last in adoration going from Pentecost 2019 to Pentecost 2020. May this abundance of prayers be like a shower of graces and blessings spread over the country! May Mary, Our Mother who took part in the first novena of Pentecost, please accompany us in this novena and this adoration for a necessary change of behavior and mentality for the liberation of Haiti."

The people of St. Joseph will implement this practice at adoration every Thursday evening. Let us join them in fervent prayer: God bless the people of Haiti.
