My first task was to make sure that we became a 501(c)(3) organization under the name of Helping Hugs. Mary Lynch, Sandra Hochwald, and I became the organization leaders, meeting at Wake-up Coffee and scratching our heads. Since I speak French, I was able to communicate with Fr. Jude Fils-Aimé to set up a helpful framework for all his chapels at Côtes-de-Fer.

Three people in our group, Diane Smith, Bill Horn and Carol Roberts went to assess the situation on the ground in Haīti. Soon after, we arranged for Fr Jude to come to St William to meet the parishioners and to speak about the many dire needs that faced his parish. When it was clear that the organization was strong and productive, I decided to step down to allow someone else with fresh ideas to lead. I have remained an active supporter.

I am so excited that Helping Hugs has developed so impressively in the past years, thanks to the immense support given by the parishioners of St. William, friends in the community and beyond. Congratulations to the Executive Committees who have worked so hard to make this happen. It will be a joy to come back, and work with the current Executive Committee and with Msgr. Christopher J. Schreck, who has shown his keen interest to help us move forward.
