Second Well to be Drilled at Bouca Moran A Report from the Water Committee

Our **Detective Dick,** who was first recognized in the February issue of this newsletter, is still digging for information! He has asked the well-digger to find the best location for the next well at St. Lawrence chapel in the village of Bouca Moran.

Following up on a lead from another HH volunteer, Dick has sought out BRIGHTEN HAITI to supply solar panels to power the next pump.

BRIGHTEN HAITI collects end of life, low power, obsolete, safe, functioning silicon based solar panels from project owners, distributors and manufacturers. They aggregate and test them for safety and usable power at a US "collection site". Then they ship them to Haiti to be sold at substantially lower than market pricing to families and business lacking electricity.

This partnership with another non-profit organization will stretch our well construction dollars and provide a less expensive source of solar power for the Côtes-de-Fer community.
